

## Some Information About Homework Assignments

There are two types of homework assignments:

1. Type 1:

Exercises are assigned from the textbook (Mathematical Statistics With Applications - 6th Edition). These exercises will not be collected. Some might be discussed in class, and students are urged to do these problems before coming to class on the day the discussion is to take place. The exercise numbers will be published on our TA's web page

The assignments are labelled as HW1, HW2, etc, and the exercises to be discussed in class in a given assignment will be marked by an asterisk.

Solutions to all exercises in the book are available in the Solutions Manual, which has been placed on reserve at Marston's Science Library. Solutions to the problems discussed in class will also be published on our TA's web page.

2. Type 2:

Exercises are assigned from outside the textbook. The statements of these exercises will be published on the TA's web page. These assignments, which are labelled as HW-A, HW-B, etc., will be collected and graded. The solutions to these problems will be published on the TA's web page after they have been collected. For this reason, late homeworks will not be accepted. The maximum homework score for the semester is 50.
