Q.1. A random sample of $n = 3$ movies was taken, and for each movie, the US theater revenues (X_1 , in millions) and percent positive reviews on Rotten Tomatoes (X_2) were observed. Compute the deviation vectors, sample mean vector, variance-covariance matrix, and correlation matrix: \mathbf{d}_1 , \mathbf{d}_2 , $\bar{\mathbf{x}}$, \mathbf{S}_n , \mathbf{R}

Movie	X1	X2
1	120	50
2	95	75
3	145	25

obtain Σ and use that to obtain ρ . $\lambda_1 = 31.466$ $\mathbf{e}_1 = \begin{bmatrix} -0.840 \\ -0.543 \end{bmatrix}$ $\lambda_2 = 9.534$ $\mathbf{e}_2 = \begin{bmatrix} 0.543 \\ -0.840 \end{bmatrix}$

Q.3. Among a population of English Premier League football players, Heights (x_1 , in inches) and Weights (x_2 , in pounds) are Normally distributed with the following Mean and Variance-Covariance matrices:

$$\boldsymbol{\mu} = \begin{bmatrix} 71.71 \\ 168.67 \end{bmatrix} \quad \boldsymbol{\Sigma} = \begin{bmatrix} 8.21 & 34.45 \\ 34.45 & 301.28 \end{bmatrix}$$

p.3.a. Obtain the correlation between height and weight, ρ , and the angle between the deviation vectors, θ :

$$\mathbf{d}_1 = \mathbf{y}_1 - \mu_1 \mathbf{1} = \begin{bmatrix} x_{11} - \mu_1 \\ \vdots \\ x_{N1} - \mu_1 \end{bmatrix} \quad \text{and} \quad \mathbf{d}_2 = \mathbf{y}_2 - \mu_2 \mathbf{1} = \begin{bmatrix} x_{12} - \mu_2 \\ \vdots \\ x_{N2} - \mu_2 \end{bmatrix}$$

Q.4. A random sample of $n = 16$ regular season NBA games for Shaquille O'Neal was obtained. We would like to test whether his population mean points scored per game is 25 and population mean rebounds per game is 15. The sample mean vector and covariance matrix are given below, where x_1 is points and x_2 is rebounds.

$$\boldsymbol{\mu}_0 = \begin{bmatrix} 25 \\ 15 \end{bmatrix} \quad \bar{\mathbf{x}} = \begin{bmatrix} 25.6 \\ 12.5 \end{bmatrix} \quad \mathbf{S} = \begin{bmatrix} 79.2 & 10.5 \\ 10.5 & 11.3 \end{bmatrix} \quad \mathbf{S}^{-1} = \begin{bmatrix} 0.0144 & -0.0134 \\ -0.0134 & 0.1009 \end{bmatrix}$$

p.4.a. Test $H_0 : \boldsymbol{\mu} = \boldsymbol{\mu}_0$ $H_A : \boldsymbol{\mu} \neq \boldsymbol{\mu}_0$ at $\alpha = 0.05$ significance level
